THE LAND TRANSPORT REGULATORY AUTHORITY (APPLICATION OF VEHICLE TRACKING SYSTEM) REGULATIONS, 2024

PART I PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

- Citation 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Land Transport Regulatory Authority (Application of Vehicle Tracking System) Regulations, 2024.
- Application 2. These Regulations shall apply to supplier and service provider in application of vehicle tracking system in Mainland Tanzania.
- Interpretation **3**. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires-
- ^{Cap. 413} "Act" means the Land Transport Regulatory Authority Act;

Cap. 130

- "Authority" means the Land Transport Regulatory Authority established underthe Act
- "Application Programming Interface" in its acronym "API" means a way in whichtwo or more computer programs enabled to communicate with each other;
- "Bureau" means Tanzania Bureau of Standards established under the Standards Act.
 - "Vehicle Tracking Device" or in its acronym "VTD" means a device and its accessories installed in a public service vehicle capable of recording,
 - transmitting data and regulating vehicle movement;
 - "Vehicle Tracking System" or in its acronym "VTS" means a system which receives, stores, tracks and shows in real time, vehicles movement and tendency;

"supplier" means a registered company or government entity dealing with supply and installation of VTD;

- "service provider" means a person who is licensed as an owner of a motor vehicle under the Transport Licensing (Public Service Vehicle) Regulations for provision of regulated services;
- "Global System for Mobile Communication" or in its acronym "GSM" means a digital mobile network widely used by mobile phones operators in the world for data transmission: and
- "Global Positioning System" or in its acronym "GPS" means a navigation system using satellites, receiver and algorithms to synchronize location, velocity and time data for air, sea and land transport.

PART II

APPROVAL TO THE SUPPLIER

Application

4.-(1) A person who intends to supply and install VTD for certificate of approval to in a vehicle shall apply to the Authority for approval in the supply VTD Form set out in the First Schedule and pay an application fee as prescribed in the Third Schedule.

> (2) The application under subregulation (1) shall be accompanied with:

- (a) a copy of certificate of incorporation;
- (b) a copy of valid business licence;
- (c) a copy of title deed or lease agreement for office accommodation;
- (d) a valid Tax Clearance Certificate; and
- (e) a sample VTD intended to be installed.

Eligibility for 5. The Authority may approve a supplier of VTD under approval of these Regulations wheresupplier

- (a) the supplier is a company incorporated in Tanzania or a government entity;
- (b) the supplier has provided technical documentation and firmware of the VTD for recording and processing the transmitted data through the Authority's VTS;
 - 4

- (c) the supplier has VTD that-
 - (i) is capable of recording, storing and transmitting data in real time;
 - (ii) meets the standards set out by the Bureau;
 - (iii) has no effect on the normal operations of vehicle;
 - (iv) is capable of recording and storing events information while disconnected from GSM network and updating back to the central server upon connection to GSM network;
 - (v) is capable of transmitting data to the Authority's VTS;
 - (vi) is capable of transmitting GPS values at a specified time interval;
 - (vii) is "failsafe" in such a way that if the plug to the electronic controller is removed, power is disconnected or if the speed signal or wire is disconnected the vehicle shall not be able to be driven in excesss peed; and
 - (viii) is equipped with means of accepting an external device and secure remote connection for testing the VTD and verifying its functionality.
- (d) the supplier has enough skilled man power for installation and maintenance of the VTD;
- (e) the supplier has submitted to the Authority the manufacturer authorisation certificate and proof of at least one year warrant of the VTD;
- (f) the supplier meets the requirements of compliance as provided in the Second Schedule subject to testing under these Regulations; and
- (g) the supplier has paid the required fees as prescribed in the Third Schedule.

Performance 6. Upon receipt of the application, the Authority shall require the supplier to configure and install the VTD in the vehicle for testing.

Approval of

7.-(1) The Authority may within fourteen days from the VTD supplier date of receipt of application and upon being satisfied with eligibility of the supplier under regulation 5 and the results of VTD performance testing under regulation 6, approve the supplier to supply VTD.

(2) The Authority may, refuse the application for approval of VTD supplier if-

- (a) the applicant fails to meet the eligibility criteria under regulation 5;
- (b) the applicant is engaged in dishonest or fraudulent conducts:
- (c) the applicant fails to pay the prescribed fee; and
- (d) the applicant's VTD fails performance test under regulation 6.

(3) Where the Authority refuses to approve a supplier, it may, within fourteen days from the date of refusal, direct the applicant to rectify the identified defaults and resubmit the application for approval.

(4) Where the applicant fails to rectify the defaults within thirty days from the date of refusal, the applicant shall be required to submit a new application.

Certificate of approval

8.-(1) The Authority shall issue a certificate of approval to the approved supplier of VTD.

(2) The certificate of approval shall be valid for a period of three years subject to renewal.

(3) The approved supplier shall be required to pay the required fees as prescribed in the Third Schedule to these Regulations.

Renewal of certificat e of approval

9.-(1) The owner of a certificate of approval shall, in not less than thirty days prior to the expiration of the term of certificate of approval, submit an application forrenewal in the form set out in the First Schedule to these Regulations.

(2) The application for renewal shall be accompanied with the followingdocuments:

(a) a copy of valid business licence;

- (b) a valid Tax Clearance Certificate; and
- (c) a copy of title deed or lease agreement for office

accommodation in case of changes.

(3) Upon receipt of an application for renewal under this regulation, the Authority may renew certificate of approval subject to provisions of these Regulations.

Suspension of certificate of approval for the following reasons: **10.-(1)** The Authority shall suspend the certificate of

- (a) where it is proved that the supplier has engaged in dishonest or fraudulent conducts;
- (b) failure to rectify malfunction of VTD within twentyfour hours for three occurrences;
- (c) proof of false or misleading information;
- (d) proof of tampering with VTD;
- (e) proof of existence of VTD vulnerabilities; and
- (f) proof of contravention of these Regulations.

(2) Where the violation is in relation to tampering with the VTS, the suspension shall be for not less than thirty days.

(3) The reasons for suspension or cancellation under subregulation (1) may be used as reasons for disqualification during renewal of certificate of approval.

PART III

CONDITIONS FOR SUPPLY OF VEHICLE TRACKING DEVICE

Conditions for supplier of VTD

11.A supplier of VTD shall-

- (a) supply and install VTD to service provider's vehicle by either selling, leasing or hiring;
- (b) provide maintenance services to supplied VTD within twenty-four hours from occurrence or reporting the malfunction;
- (c) prepare a middleware or an integrating mechanism with the Authority's VTS platform using given API or another agreed mechanism;
- (d) ensure that VTD is continuously transmitting data directly to VTS;

- (e) comply with required specifications of the VTD prescribed by theAuthority;
- (f) provide training on the use of VTD to service providers and other stakeholders;
- (g) provide access of the VTD to the Authority when required;
- (h) ensure that information obtained in the course of the supplier's services are notdisclosed to another person without prior approval of the Authority;
- (i) ensure that VTD is failsafe and is installed in such a way that it is nottampered with;
- (j) ensure that technicians wear uniforms with the supplier's logo and identity cards while on duty;
- (k) ensure that the technicians prepare a job card of the inspection or maintenance carried out;
- (1) not terminate services to the service provider, without prior notice of thirty days to the Authority;
- (m) enter into contract with the service provider prior to installation of VTD; and
- (n) inform the service provider and the Authority regarding the malfunctioning of the VTD within six hours.

Conditions to service provider

- 12. A service provider shall ensure that-
- (a) the VTD is installed in the vehicle by a supplier approved by the Authority;
- (b) the VTD is protected against hazardous conditions, tampering and is working properly at all times;
- (c) any malfunction or damage of the VTD is reported within two hours to the supplier and where no action is taken by the supplier, he notices the Authority within the twelve hours from occurrence of such malfunction or damage;
- (d) an officer of the Authority or the supplier is provided with access to inspect the VTD without any obstruction;
- (e) the Authority is informed where the supplier has not rectified the malfunction of the VTD within twentyfour hours; and
- (f) the arrears to the supplier are paid before entering into

an agreement with another supplier.

PART IV GENERAL PROVISIONS

VTD not to affect functioning of vehicle	13(1) The installation of the VTD shall not affect the normal functioning of the vehicle.(2) Any damage resulting from installation of the VTD shall be compensated by the supplier.
SIM card service charges	14. The supplier shall be responsible to bear data service charges arising from the use of SIM cards provided by the Authority.
Request for access to VTS	 15(1) The service provider may request from the Authority access to VTS information for the purpose of monitoring the performance of his vehicle. (2) The Authority may, upon receipt of the application under subregulation (1) open a monitoring account for the service provider.
Offences and penalties	16. A person who contravenes the provisions of these Regulations, commits an offence and on conviction shall be liable to a fine of not less than five hundred thousand shillings but not exceeding one million shillings, or to imprisonment for a term of not less than one year but not exceeding two years or to both.
Review GN. No. 73 of 2020	17. A person aggrieved by the decision of the Authority under these Regulations may, within fourteen days from the date of the decision, apply to the Authority for review, in accordance with the Land Transport Regulatory Authority (Review Procedure) Rules.

Apeal**18.** Subject to the provisions of Fair Competition Act, aCap. 285person aggrieved by the decision of the Board may appeal to the
Fair Competition Tribunal.
