THE NATIVE FOODSTUFFS ORDINANCE

(CAP. 76)

ORDER

Made by the District Commissioner, Handeni District, under section 3

THE NATIVE FOODSTUFFS (HANDENI DISTRICT) ORDER, 1962

1. This Order may be cited as the Native Foodstuffs (Handeni District) Order, 1962, and shall remain in force for one year only.

2. No person shall remove any maize, millet, sorghum, cassava, maize flour, millet flour, sorghum flour or cassava flour from the Handeni District without having previously obtained the written permission of the District Commissioner of the said District.

3. No person shall by means of barter or purchase acquire from any native within the Handeni District any of the afore-mentioned foodstuffs for the purpose of re-sale without having previously obtained the written permission of the District Commissioner of the said District.

(CAP. 76)

ORDER

Made by the District Commissioner, Kilosa District, under section 3

THE NATIVE FOODSTUFFS (KILOSA DISTRICT) ORDER, 1962

1. This Order may be cited as the Native Foodstuffs (Kilosa District) Order, 1962, and shall remain in force until 30th June, 1963.

2. No person shall remove maize, millet or sorghum in any form from the Kilosa District, without having previously obtained the written permission of the District Commissioner of the said District.

3. No person shall by means of barter or purchase acquire any of the afore-mentioned foodstuffs from any native within Kilosa District for the purpose of re-sale without having first obtained the written permission of the District Commissioner of the said District.
