THE FISHERIES ORDINANCE
(CAP. 295)

ORDER

Under section 8 (1)

THE FISHERIES (TANGANYIKA COAST LINE AND MAFIA CONTROLLED AREA) (*SUBPHYLUM CRUSTACEA*) ORDER, 1965

1. This Order may be cited as the Fisheries (Tanganyika Coast Line and Mafia Controlled Area) (*Subphylum Crustacea*) Order, 1965.

2. The whole coast line of Tanganyika, including the Islands of the Mafia group, which is bounded on the north by the boundary with Kenya, to the east by the waters of the Indian Ocean, to the south by the boundary with Portuguese East Africa and extending across the Indian Ocean for a distance of ten nautical miles measured from the Mean High Water Spring Tide mark, and all waters therein, are hereby declared to be a controlled area in which the capture, killing, preparation and disposal of *Subphylum Crustacea* (which includes crabs, lobsters and shrimps) shall be controlled and regulated.

3. The Fisheries (Rufiji Controlled Area) Order is hereby revoked. G.N. 1961
