THE IMMIGRATION (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1962

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Amendment) Regulations, 1962, and shall be read as one with the Immigration Regulations, 1957.

2. Regulation 23 of the Immigration Regulations, 1957, is hereby amended by inserting immediately after paragraph (4) thereof the following new paragraph to be numbered (4A):

“(4A) The principal Immigration Officer may in his absolute discretion at any time cancel any Visitor’s Pass issued under this regulation.”

3. Regulation 25 of the Immigration Regulations, 1957, is hereby amended as follows:

(a) by deleting sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) of paragraph (1) thereof and substituting therefor the following:—

“(a) shall issue a Re-entry Pass to any person who is the holder of a certificate of permanent residence granted to him in accordance with section 8 of the Ordinance and who desires to leave the Territory temporarily; and

(b) may, in his discretion and subject to such condition as he may impose, issue a Re-entry Pass to any person, other than a person mentioned in paragraph (a), lawfully present in the Territory who desires to leave the Territory temporarily.”; and

(b) by deleting the words “and shall be endorsed on the passport of the holder”, appearing in the third and fourth lines of paragraph (3) thereof.
