“with effect from the twenty-second day of January, 1965, the Council shall consist of not more than thirty-six members, twenty-five of whom shall be elected in pursuance of the Dar es Salaam Municipal Council (Election Declaration) Order, 1961, and in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Election (Urban Areas) Ordinance, and the remainder (not exceeding eleven in number) appointed by the President.”

3. Rule 6 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by adding the words “or appointment” immediately after the word “election” occurring in the third line of paragraph 1 thereof.

THE EDUCATION ORDINANCE, 1961
(No. 37 OF 1961)

REGULATIONS

Made under section 38

THE EDUCATION (PUBLIC SCHOOL ACCOUNTS) REGULATIONS, 1965

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Education (Public School Accounts) Regulations, 1965.

2. All Education Secretaries-General, Education Secretaries, Local Education Authorities, owners and managers of schools, Boards of Governors, School Committees and heads of public schools shall submit to the Minister or his representative duly certified accounts or extracts from accounts of expenditure and revenue in respect of the public school or the group of public schools under his respective control or direction.

3. Such accounts or extracts from accounts shall be submitted at such times and with such explanations in respect thereof as may be specified from time to time in writing by the Minister or his representative.

4. Without prejudice to the provisions of regulations 2 and 3, the Minister or his representative may at any reasonable time examine or cause to be examined the accounts of any public school or group of public schools in respect of the receipt and expenditure of any grants-in-aid paid in accordance with the Education (Grant-in-Aid) Regulations, 1961, including any grants-in-aid paid by Local Education Authority, and the receipt and expenditure of subventions paid in accordance with the Education (Subventions) Regulations, 1963.
