**PROCLAMATION**

*Under section 3*

DECLARATION OF NGURDOTO CRATER NATIONAL PARK EXTENSION

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 3 of the National Parks Ordinance, 1959, and with the consent of the National Assembly, I, RICHARD GORDON TURNBULL, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General of Tanganyika, do hereby declare the area of land described in the Schedule hereto to be a national park for the purposes of the said Ordinance.

SCHEDULE

NGURDOTO CRATER NATIONAL PARK EXTENSION

All that area adjoining Momella Estate amounting to 5,032 acres contained by a succession of straight line boundaries commencing at survey beacon L514, then passing in turn through survey beacons EE7, EE8, EE6, M771, M772, EE5, TC16, CP6, TC17, E666, L515 and thence to L514, more particularly defined as the area edged yellow on registered plan No. 12080 deposited with the Survey Division of the Ministry of Lands, Forests and Wildlife.
