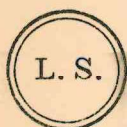

THE LOCAL LIQUOR ORDINANCE
(CAP. 77)

BY-LAWS

Made under section 56

THE NACHINGWEA DISTRICT COUNCIL (LOCAL LIQUOR) BY-LAWS, 1965

1. These By-laws may be cited as the Nachingwea District Council (Local Liquor) By-laws, 1965, and shall apply to the Nachingwea District.

2. The fees chargeable in the Nachingwea District for licences to manufacture and sell local liquor shall be as follows: —

3. No fee shall be chargeable for a permit to manufacture local liquor for private consumption on premises specified in the permit by the owner of such premises and his friends and not for purposes of sale.

4. All licences and permits issued by the Licensing Officer shall be in the form set out in the Schedule hereto.

5. No local liquor shall be sold before the hour of 2.00 p.m. and after 6.00 p.m. on any day.

6. The Nachingwea Native Authority (Native Beer) (Control of Sales) Rules, 1954 are hereby revoked.
