NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the President by section 2 of the Customs (Dumping and Subsidies Rates) Ordinance and all other powers thereto me enabling, I do hereby make the following Order: —

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs (Anti-Dumping) (Aluminium Holloware) Order, 1965 and shall come into operation on the twentieth day of August, 1965.

2. The duty of customs on the goods set out in the Schedule hereto shall be charged at the rate of 15 per cent *ad valorem* and such duty shall be charged without any limitation of period.

ORDER

Under section 4

THE CUSTOMS (ANTI-DUMPING DUTY) (STEEL KARAIS) ORDER, 1965

WHEREAS the Common Services Organization in pursuance of section 3 of the Customs (Dumping and Subsidies) Act, 1959, has made a report to the Government of the United Republic of Tanzania that the goods of the description set out in the Schedule to this Order are being imported into the territories from India in circumstances in which they are under the provision of this Act to be regarded as having been dumped:

AND WHEREAS, in accordance with section 4 of the said Act, the President may, if having regard to all the circumstances he considers it in the public interest so to do, make an order imposing a duty of customs on such goods:

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 4 of the Customs (Dumping and Subsidies) Act, 1959 and all other powers thereto him enabling, the President hereby makes the following Order: —
