THE PRODUCE CESS ACT, 1962

(No. 53 of 1962)

ORDER

Under section 3

THE PRODUCE CESS (GENERAL AMENDMENT OF RATES) ORDER, 1965

1. This Order may be cited as the Produce Cess (General Amendment of Rates) Order, 1965, and shall come into force on the second day of April, 1965.

2. The Schedules to all Orders made or deemed to have been made under the Produce Cess Act 1962 and in force at the commencement of this Order are hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) by deleting the rates specified for the produce set out therein and by substituting therefor the rates set out for the appropriate produce in the Schedule to this Order; and
- (b) by adding at the end of the column specifying the rates for produce, the following new proviso:—

“Provided that where any cess payable on any description of produce at any particular time would, if calculated in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Order—

be the cess payable on such produce to the nearest 5 cents or multiple of 5 cents to the cess so calculated.”.

Cashew nuts	5 per cent <i>ad valorem</i> .
Coffee, clean parchment	5 per cent <i>ad valorem</i> .
Cotton	2 per cent <i>ad valorem</i> .
Gum Arabic	3 per cent <i>ad valorem</i> .
Maize	4 per cent <i>ad valorem</i> .
Paddy	4 per cent <i>ad valorem</i> .
Pyrethrum	1 per cent <i>ad valorem</i> .
Sisal fibre	1 per cent <i>ad valorem</i> .
Sugar	1 per cent <i>ad valorem</i> .
Tobacco	5 per cent <i>ad valorem</i> .
Tea Cess	1 per cent <i>ad valorem</i> .
Vegetables, all descriptions	2 per cent <i>ad valorem</i> .
Grains, not otherwise specified	4 per cent <i>ad valorem</i> .
Any other produce	5 per cent <i>ad valorem</i> .
