THE TEA ORDINANCE
(CAP. 291)

RULES

Made under section 29

THE TEA (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1962

1. These Rules may be cited as the Tea (Amendment) Rules, 1962, and shall be read as one with the Tea Rules (hereinafter called the principal Rules).

2. Rule 6 of the principal Rules is hereby amended—

- (a) by deleting the symbols and word “31st December” from the third line thereof, and substituting therefor the symbols and word “30th June”; and
- (b) by deleting the symbols and word “15th January” from the last line thereof and substituting therefor the symbols and word “15th July”.

3. The principal Rules are hereby amended by inserting immediately after rule 7 thereof the following new rule to be numbered 7A:—

“7A. Every person applying under section 10 of the Ordinance for a licence to plant tea shall make application therefor in the form set out in the Fifth Schedule to these Rules.”

4. The Fourth Schedule to the principal Rules is hereby amended—

- (a) by deleting the symbols and word “31st December” wherever they occur therein and substituting therefor in each case the symbols and word “30th June”; and
- (b) by deleting the words and symbols “on or before the 15th day of January,” in the note at the foot thereof and substituting therefor the words and symbols “on or before the 15th day of July”.

5. The principal Rules are hereby amended by adding immediately after the Fourth Schedule thereto the following new schedule:—
