THE NATIVE FOODSTUFFS ORDINANCE
(CAP. 76)

ORDER

Made by the District Commissioner, Ufipa District, under section 3

THE NATIVE FOODSTUFFS (UFIPA DISTRICT) ORDER, 1962

1. This Order may be cited as the Native Foodstuffs (Ufipa District) Order, 1962, and shall remain in force for one year only.

2. No person shall remove cassava, maize, millet, and meals made therefrom, rice, paddy or sweet potatoes from the Ufipa District without having previously obtained the written permission of the District Commissioner of the said District.

3. No person shall by means of barter or purchase acquire from any native within the Ufipa District any of the aforementioned foodstuffs for the purpose of re-sale, without having previously obtained the written permission of the District Commissioner of the said District.

ORDER

Made by the District Commissioner, Arusha District, under section 3

THE NATIVE FOODSTUFFS (ARUSHA DISTRICT) ORDER, 1962

1. This Order may be cited as the Native Foodstuffs (Arusha District) Order, 1962, and shall remain in force up to 30th June, 1962.

2. No person shall remove any maize or maize flour, millet, sorghum, or other millets, or cassava from the Arusha District without having previously obtained the written permission of the District Commissioner of the said District.
