AGREEMENT

*Amendment to the Constitution of the Organization published under
section 2 (2)*

EAST AFRICAN COMMON SERVICES ORGANIZATION (AMENDMENT)
(No. 2) AGREEMENT, 1963

By an Agreement, to be cited as the East African Common Services
Organization (Amendment) Agreement (No. 2), 1963, made between the
Governments of Tanganyika, Uganda and Kenya, the Constitution of the
Organization is amended, as follows: —

Amendment to the Constitution

In Article 29, paragraph 2 of Article 30, paragraph 4 of Article
31, and sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph 2 of Article 31, the words
“the Governor-General” shall be deleted and the words “the
President of Uganda” substituted therefor.

THE REGULATION OF WAGES AND TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT
ORDINANCE
(CAP. 300)

ORDER

THE PRIVATE DOMESTIC EMPLOYEES WAGES COUNCIL (ESTABLISHMENT)
ORDER, 1964

WHEREAS the Minister for Labour is of the opinion that no adequate
machinery exists for the effective regulation of remuneration of the
terms of employment of domestic employees employed in private
houses in the Republic.

NOW THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by
section 6 of the Regulation of Wages and Terms of Employment Ordinance,
the Minister for Labour hereby makes the following Order: —
