THE TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) (No. 3) RULES, 1962

1. These Rules may be cited as the Traffic (Amendment) (No. 3) Rules, 1962 and shall be read as one with the Traffic Rules. Cap. 168

2. Rule 62 of the Traffic Rules is hereby revoked and replaced by the following:—

“Registration 62. The Chief Electrical and Mechanical Engineer, Ministry of Communications, Power and Works, shall keep and maintain a register of all government vehicles and trailers owned by the Government and shall allot to each a number which shall be preceded by the letters “T.R.” in the case of military vehicles and trailers, and in all other cases a number, letter or symbol which shall be preceded by the letters “G.T.”. The necessary identification plates shall be issued by the Chief Electrical and Mechanical Engineer and any vehicle or trailer which immediately prior to the coming into operation of these Rules was registered in the manner prescribed herein shall be deemed to have been registered in pursuance of this Rule.”

THE MEAT HYGIENE ORDINANCE, 1960

(No. 34 OF 1960)

REGULATIONS

Made under section 17 (3)

THE MEAT HYGIENE (APPLICATION TO DAR ES SALAAM) REGULATIONS, 1962

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Meat Hygiene (Application to Dar es Salaam) Regulations, 1962.

2. The Meat Hygiene Regulations, 1962 shall apply, with effect from G.N. 1962 the seventh day of May, 1962, to the City of Dar es Salaam and within No. 81 one mile of the city boundaries.
