THE PRISONS ORDINANCE

(CAP. 58)

RULES

Made under section 124

THE PRISONS (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1962

1. The Rules may be cited as the Prisons (Amendment) Rules, 1962, and shall be read as one with the Prisons Rules. Supp. 55

2. Rule 3 of the Prisons Rules is hereby amended by deleting paragraph (n) thereof.

3. Rule 4 of the Prisons Rules is hereby deleted and replaced by the following:—

“4—(1) Standard sleeping equipment for prisoners shall consist of one sleeping mat and such number of blankets as a Medical Officer may recommend:

Provided that any prisoner who at the date of publication of these regulations has the use of any additional sleeping equipment may continue to have the use of such equipment until his discharge.

(2) Additional sleeping equipment, including a bedstead, pillows and sheets may be issued, on the recommendation of a Medical Officer, to any prisoner, and in the discretion of the officer-in-charge of the prison to a convict leader in charge of a prison ward.

(3) Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraphs (1) and (2) of this regulation a civil debtor may be issued with a bedstead, pillows and sheets or may provide his own sleeping equipment.
