## REGULATIONS

*Under section 18*THE NGURDOTO CRATER NATIONAL PARK (AMENDMENT)  
REGULATIONS, 1962

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Ngurdoto Crater National Park (Amendment) Regulations, 1962.

## THE SUBORDINATE COURTS ORDINANCE

(CAP. 3)

## ORDER

*Made under section 5 (8)*THE SUBORDINATE COURTS (MAGISTERIAL POWERS AND JURISDICTION)  
(No. 4) ORDER, 1962

1. This Order may be cited as the Subordinate Courts (Magisterial Powers and Jurisdiction) (No. 4) Order, 1962.

2. The persons specified in the First Schedule hereto shall have the powers and jurisdiction of a third class magistrate for criminal work only and restricted to remands and applications for bail.

3. Every reference to a magistrate contained in the written laws specified in the Second Schedule hereto shall be deemed to include a reference to the persons specified in the First Schedule hereto.

## THE NATIVE FOODSTUFFS ORDINANCE

(CAP. 76)

## ORDER

*Made by the District Commissioner, Rufiji District, under section 3*

## THE NATIVE FOODSTUFFS (RUFJI DISTRICT) ORDER, 1962

1. This Order may be cited as the Native Foodstuffs (Rufiji District) Order, 1962, and shall remain in force for one year only.

2. No person shall remove any maize, cassava, or any flours or meals made therefrom, from the Rufiji District without having previously obtained the written permission of the District/Area Commissioner of the said District.

3. No person shall by means of barter or purchase acquire from any native within the Rufiji District any of the afore-mentioned foodstuffs for the purpose of re-sale without having previously obtained the written permission of the District/Area Commissioner of the said District.
