THE FISHERIES (CONTROLLED AREAS) (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1965

1. These Rules may be cited as the Fisheries (Controlled Areas) (Amendment) Rules, 1965, and shall be read as one with the Fisheries (Controlled Areas) Rules, 1961 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules).

2. Rule 3 of the principal Rules is hereby revoked and replaced by the following new rule:—

“Fishing

prohibited

3.—(1) No person shall either on his own account or as an agent or employee—

(a) kill or capture any fish, the capture or killing of which is controlled or regulated under an Order made under the provisions of section 8 (1) of the Fisheries Ordinance;

(b) prepare, purchase, sell, or dispose of any such fish or fish products derived from such fish unless licensed in that behalf under the provisions of Rule 4 of these Rules.

(2) This rule shall not apply to the killing or capture of fish, or to the preparation or purchase of fish by any person solely for his own domestic consumption nor shall it apply to citizens of Tanzania ordinarily resident within the controlled area unless such citizens carry on fishing as a commercial enterprise either on their own account or as agents or employees of another person.”.
