(iv) Every motor omnibus in respect of which a licence issued under these By-laws is in force, shall carry such licence on the nearside lower corner of the windscreen thereof, in such manner as to be clearly visible.

5. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any of the provisions of these By-laws shall be guilty of an offence and on conviction shall be liable to a fine not exceeding one thousand shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or to both such fine and imprisonment.

THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE

(CAP. 333)

BY-LAWS

Made under section 59

THE DODOMA DISTRICT COUNCIL (CULTIVATION OF AGRICULTURAL LAND) BY-LAWS, 1965

1. These By-laws may be cited as the Dodoma District Council (Cultivation of Agricultural Land) By-laws, 1965.

2. In these By-laws—

“Authorized Officer” means an officer appointed by the Council for the purposes of these By-laws;

“Cash Crops” means any marketable agricultural produce and include groundnuts, maize, castor seed, cassava, millet and potatoes;

“Council” means the Dodoma District Council;

“Resident” means any person who has habitually resided in the area of jurisdiction of the Council for a period of not less than a year but does not include persons—

- (a) who are under eighteen years of age;
- (b) who are over the age of fifty years;
- (c) who are engaged in full-time remunerative occupation;
- (d) who are incapable of working due to illness or infirmity.

3. Every resident who holds agricultural land in accordance with the local customary law relating to land tenure shall cultivate and maintain the cashcrops specified in Column One of the Schedule hereto on the acreage prescribed opposite thereto in the Second Column.

4. Any person who has planted or cultivated any cash crop or crops on his agricultural land and finds such cash crop or crops infested or infected with insect, plant pest or disease shall promptly report such infestation or infection to the authorized officer and shall comply with such instructions as may be given by such officer for the destruction of the insect, plant pest or disease and the prevention of its spread.

5. Subject to the provisions of this By-Law, no person shall fell or uproot or cause to be felled or uprooted any cash crop or crops cultivated and maintained under the provisions of By-law 3 for any purpose other than for the purposes of agricultural improvement or the improvement of a Minor Settlement or Trading Centre.

6. An authorized officer may at all reasonable times enter upon any agricultural land for the purpose of inspection and for ensuring compliance with the provisions of these By-laws.

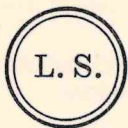
7. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with the provisions of these By-laws shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding three hundred shillings or to a sentence of imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or to both such fine and imprisonment.
