THE EDUCATION ORDINANCE  
(CAP. 446)

REGULATIONS

*Made under section 38*

THE EDUCATION (GRANTS-IN-AID) (AMENDMENT) (No. 3) REGULATIONS,  
1965

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Education (Grants-in-aid) (Amendment) (No. 3) Regulations, 1965, and shall be read as one with the Education (Grants-in-aid) Regulations, 1961, hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations, and shall come into operation on the first day of January, 1966.

2. Regulation 8 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended: —

(a) by deleting the marginal note and by substituting therefor the following new marginal note: —

“Grants in respect of salaries and leave privileges”; and

(b) by deleting paragraph (ii) and by substituting therefor the following new paragraph: —

“(i) A grant-in-aid paid under paragraph (i) shall not exceed the full approved salaries and leave privileges of the staff in respect of whom it is paid.”;

3. Regulation 12 of the principal Regulations is hereby revoked and replaced by the following new regulation: —

“Miscellaneous recurrent grants

12.—(i) Grants-in-aid may be paid in respect of the following recurrent expenses of schools, training institutions and vocational schools: —

- (a) expenses of providing approved equipment;
- (b) general administration and upkeep expenses; and
- (c) expenses connected with boarding facilities.

(ii) Grants-in-aid paid under the paragraph (i) shall not, except where the Minister has in special circumstances otherwise authorized in writing, exceed the rates prescribed in the Schedule ‘B’.”

4. The Schedule “B” to the principal Regulations is hereby deleted and replaced by the following new Schedule.

THE LOCAL INDUSTRIES (REFUND OF CUSTOMS DUTIES) (SAPA)  
(EXTENSION) ORDER, 1965

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Industries (Refund of Customs Duties) (SAPA) (Extension) Order, 1965 and shall be read as one with the Local Industries (Refund of Customs Duties) (No. 5) (Order), 1958 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order").

2. The principal Order as extended by the Local Industries (Refund of Customs Duties) (No. 5) 1958 (Extension) Order, 1964 shall have effect as if for the words "until the 1st August, 1965 unless earlier revoked" in the second and third lines of paragraph 1 thereof there were substituted the words "until the 1st August, 1966".
