**BY-LAWS**

THE SINGIDA DISTRICT COUNCIL (CULTIVATION OF AGRICULTURAL  
LAND) BY-LAWS, 1965

1. These By-laws may be cited as the Singida District Council  
(Cultivation of Agricultural Land) By-laws, 1965.

2. In these By-laws—

“authorized officer” means an officer appointed by the Council for the  
purposes of these By-laws;

“Council” means the Singida District Council;

“District” means the area under the jurisdiction of the Singida District  
Council;

“Cash Crops” include Cotton, Castor seed and Groundnuts;

“Food Crops” include maize and all other cereals, root crops including  
cassava, sweet and Irish potatoes and pulses;

“Resident” means any person who has habitually resided in the area  
of jurisdiction of the Council for a period of not less than a year but  
does not include persons—

- (a) who are under eighteen years of age;
- (b) who are over the age of fifty years;
- (c) who are incapable of working due to illness or infirmity;
- (d) who are engaged in full-time remunerative occupation.

3. Every resident who holds land in accordance with the local  
customary law relating to land tenure shall unless directed in writing  
by an authorized officer cultivate and maintain an area of not less than  
two acres of cash crops and three acres of food crops:

Provided that in the case of cotton the acreage and the area shall be  
determined and selected by an authorized officer.

4. Any person who has planted or cultivated any cash or food crop  
on his agricultural land and finds such cash or food crop infested or  
infected with insect, plant pest or disease, shall promptly report such  
infestation or infection to the authorized officer and shall comply with  
such instructions as may be given by such officer for the destruction of  
such insect, plant pest or disease and the prevention of its spread.

5. Subject to the provisions of these By-laws, no person shall fell or uproot or cause to be felled or uprooted any cash or food crop cultivated and maintained under the provisions of By-law 3 for any purpose other than for the purposes of agricultural improvements or the improvement of a Township, Minor Settlement or Trading Centre.

6. Any authorized officer may at all reasonable times enter upon any agricultural land for the purpose of inspection and for ensuring compliance with the provisions of these By-laws.

7. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with the provisions of these By-laws shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding two hundred shillings or to a sentence of imprisonment for a term not exceeding two months or to both such fine and imprisonment.

**BY-LAWS**

*Made under section 59*

THE NJOMBE DISTRICT COUNCIL (LICENSING AND CONTROL OF DOGS)  
BY-LAWS, 1965

1. These By-laws may be cited as the Njombe District Council (Licensing and Control of Dogs) By-laws, 1965 and shall apply to the Njombe District.

2. In these By-laws—

“authorized person” includes any Veterinary Officer, Field Officer of the Veterinary Division, Administrative Officer and any person authorized in writing by the Director of Veterinary Services to exercise the powers contained in subsection (2) (e) of section 22 of the Animal Diseases Ordinance;

“Council” means the Njombe District Council;

“District” means the area of jurisdiction of the Njombe District Council;
