THE FORESTS ORDINANCE

(CAP. 389)

ORDER*Under section 5 (1) and 33 (b), and under section 13 of the Constitution*THE FORESTS (MOMBO TERRITORIAL FOREST RESERVE) (VARIATION)
ORDER, 1962

1. This Order may be cited as the Forests (Mombo Territorial Forest Reserve) (Variation) Order, 1962.

2. The description of the Mombo Territorial Forest Reserve in the Lushoto District, as contained in the Schedule of Territorial Forest Reserves, is hereby varied by substituting therefor the following:—

"Approximate area: 51 acres (0.08 square mile).

Situation and Boundaries.—All that area of land situated north and south of the main Mombo-Moshi road within 300 yards of Mombo Village in approximate latitude 4 degrees 53 minutes South and longitude 38 degrees 17 minutes East as delineated in green and described with a table of boundary bearings and distances on Forest Division Plan No. Jb 533 deposited with the Survey Division of the Ministry of Lands, Forests and Wildlife under Registration No. 12029."
