THE AFRICAN PRODUCE (CESS) ORDINANCE

(CAP. 323)

ORDER

Made by the Minister for Provincial Affairs under section 3 of the African Produce (Cess) Ordinance after consultation with and at the request of the Kinga Native Authority, and with the approval of the Governor in Council

THE AFRICAN PRODUCE (CESS) (KINGA NATIVE AUTHORITY)
ORDER, 1960

1. This Order may be cited as the African Produce (Cess) (Kinga Native Authority) Order, 1960.

2. There shall be imposed on the produce specified in column one of the Schedule hereto which is bought and sold within or exported from the area of the jurisdiction of the Kinga Native Authority, a cess payable at the rate specified in column two of the said Schedule :

Provided that this Order shall apply only to a first sale or export and that cess shall not be payable on subsequent sale or export of the same produce.

3. The cess shall be due and payable by the buyer or the exporter at the time of sale or export :

Provided that where any produce to which this Order applies has been delivered for sale to a Co-operative Society registered under the Co-operative Societies Ordinance or to a Growers' Association the cess shall become due and payable by such society or association to the Kinga Native Authority direct, through the Njombe Joint Local Treasury, at the time of payment of the proceeds of sale to it.

4.—(1) Where the sale is in a market established under the Markets Ordinance the cess shall be payable to the market clerk who is hereby authorized to receive the same for and on behalf of the Native Authority and to issue a receipt.

(2) Where the sale is effected through export elsewhere than at a market or in respect of produce delivered to a Co-operative Society or Growers' Association under the provisions of paragraph 3 of this Order the exporter or society, as the case may be, shall pay the cess to the Native Authority through the Njombe Joint Local Treasury.

5. No produce to which this Order applies and which has been bought and sold in a market established under the Markets Ordinance on which any cess is due and remains unpaid shall be removed from such market.

6. The African Produce (Cess) (Kinga Native Authority) Order, 1955, is hereby revoked.
