THE PROVISIONAL COLLECTION OF TAXES AND DUTIES ACT, 1963

(No. 10 OF 1963)

ORDER

Made under section 2

THE PROVISIONAL COLLECTION (CUSTOMS DUTIES) ORDER, 1965

WHEREAS I, RASHIDI MFAUME KAWAWA, Second Vice-President of the United Republic of Tanzania, in the discharge of the functions of the office of the President, have approved of the introduction into the National Assembly of a Bill whereby, if such Bill is passed into law, a customs duty shall be imposed on sundry articles and the customs duty payable on sundry articles shall be varied:

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested in me by the directions of the President under subsection (3) of section 7 of the Interim Constitution and by section 2 of the Provisional Collection of Taxes and Duties Act, 1963, I do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Provisional Collection (Customs Duties) Order, 1965, and shall come into operation on the first day of April, 1965.

2. There shall be charged, levied and collected on the articles respectively described or referred to in clause 2 of the Bill for an Act to amend the Customs Tariff Ordinance which is entitled the Customs Tariff Ordinance (Amendment) Act, 1965, and is published as a supplement to the same issue of the *Gazette* as is the supplement containing this Order, the customs duty which will become payable, if the said Bill is passed into law, as the customs duty to be levied on such articles, in lieu of the customs duty (if any) heretofore payable on such articles under the existing law.
