

3. The Rufiji Local Council shall be responsible for the maintenance and control of this local authority forest reserve.

THE FORESTS (MOGO TERRITORIAL FOREST RESERVE) (VARIATION)
ORDER, 1962

1. This Order may be cited as the Forests (Mogo Territorial Forest Reserve) (Variation) Order, 1962.

2. The Schedule of Territorial Forest Reserves is hereby varied by deleting the description of the Mogo Territorial Forest Reserve in the Dar es Salaam Region, as varied by the Forests (Mogo Territorial Forest Reserve) (Variation) Order, 1960, and substituting therefor the following:—
