THE AFRICAN CHIEFS ORDINANCE

(CAP. 331)

SUSPENSION ORDER

To: The Provincial Commissioner,
Central Province,
Dodoma.

CHIEF WILLIAM JIMA OF IAMBI CHIEFDOM, IRAMBA DISTRICT,
CENTRAL PROVINCE

WHEREAS one WILLIAM JIMA is Chief within the meaning of the African Chiefs Ordinance of the Chiefdom of Iambi in the Iramba District.

AND WHEREAS I, RICHARD GORDON TURNBULL, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief of Tanganyika, deem it expedient to cause inquiry into whether or not the deposition of the said WILLIAM JIMA from his office of chief aforesaid is required according to customary law or is necessary in the interests of peace, order and good government:

Now, THEREFORE, I, the said RICHARD GORDON TURNBULL in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by subsection (1) of section 14 of the African Chiefs Ordinance do hereby suspend the said WILLIAM JIMA from the said office until such inquiry has been completed and a decision has been made in the matter and do hereby require the said WILLIAM JIMA to reside in Manyoni Minor Settlement during his suspension from his office of chief aforesaid.
