(CAP. 35)

PROCLAMATION

Under section 3

DECLARATION OF PUBLIC HOLIDAYS

WHEREAS by section 3 of the Public Holidays Ordinance the Governor may, by proclamation, declare any day to be a public holiday in addition to the days mentioned in the Schedule to the said Ordinance or in substitution for any of them:

Now THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 of the Public Holidays Ordinance and all other powers thereunto enabling, I, RICHARD GORDON TURNBULL, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief of Tanganyika, do hereby proclaim and declare that the twentieth and twenty-first days of March, 1961 shall be public holidays to mark the festival of Id-el-Fitr.
