THE PRISONS ORDINANCE

(CAP. 58)

ORDER*Made under section 3***THE PRISONS (DECLARATION AND CANCELLATION OF PRISONS)
ORDER, 1962**

1. This Order may be cited as the Prisons (Declaration and Cancellation of Prisons) Order, 1962.

2. The prison established at the following place at Malya is hereby declared to be a first class prison for the purposes of the Prisons Ordinance, that is to say—

*Substituted
28/6/62*
A group of buildings surrounded by a barbed wire fence situated in approximately 3 acres of land bounded to the north by the Malya Dam, to the west by the Malya/Malampaka Highway and approximately 600 yards south-east of Malya Dam Pump Station in the Malya District.

3. The prison established at the following place at Dar es Salaam, is hereby declared to be a first class prison for the purposes of the Prisons Ordinance, that is to say—

A group of buildings surrounded by a fourteen feet wall situated adjacent to and 400 yards north-east of Keko Creek, in that area known as Keko Chini.

4. The following prisons shall cease to be prisons for the purposes of the Prisons Ordinance:—

(1) The prison established at Ngorongoro, Northern Province, and declared to be a first class prison for the purposes of the Prisons Ordinance by an Order made under the said Ordinance on the 4th February, 1955.

(2) The prison established at Lugolora, near Iringa, Southern Highlands Province, and declared to be a first class prison for the purposes of the Prisons Ordinance by an Order made under the said Ordinance on the 21st September, 1956.

(3) The prison established at Mlowa, near Iringa, Southern Highlands Province, and declared to be a first class prison for the purposes of the Prisons Ordinance by an Order made under the said Ordinance on the 6th March, 1953.

(4) The prison established at Ikwiriri, near Utete, Eastern Province, and declared to be a first class prison for the purposes of the Prisons Ordinance by an Order made under the said Ordinance on the 30th September, 1955.

THE FORESTS ORDINANCE

(CAP. 389)

ORDER

Under sections 5 (1) and 10 (1)

THE FORESTS (NAWENGE LOCAL AUTHORITY FOREST RESERVE)
(DECLARATION) ORDER, 1962

1. This Order may be cited as the Forests (Nawenge Local Authority Forest Reserve) Order, 1962.
2. The area of unreserved land within the limits defined in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a local authority forest reserve.
3. The Ulanga Council shall be responsible for the maintenance and control of this local authority forest reserve.
