**BY-LAWS**

*Made by the Musoma Town Council under section 59 of the Local Government Ordinance with the approval of the Minister for Regional Administration*

THE MUSOMA TOWNSHIP (BUS STATION) BY-LAWS, 1965

Title

1. These By-laws may be cited as the Musoma Township (Bus Station) By-laws, 1965.

Definitions

2. In these By-laws—  
“Council” means the Musoma Town Council;  
“Motor Omnibus” means any public service vehicle which carries or is intended to convey only passengers or their personal goods and is licensed to carry more than eight passengers including the driver;  
“Township” means the Township of Musoma;  
“Bus Station” means the Bus Station operated by the Council on the plot of land bounded to the South by Market Street, to the North by Majita Road and Esso Petrol Station to the East by the Central Market and to the West by the Jamhuri Gardens and any other Bus Station which may be established by the Council.

Licences

3. No Motor Omnibus plying between the Township and any place out-side the Township shall embark or disembark any passenger or his personal luggage within the Township at any place other than at a Bus Station.

4.—(i) No Motor Omnibus shall use a Bus Station unless the owner thereof is in possession of a valid licence issued in respect of that motor omnibus by the Council under these By-laws entitling such omnibus to use a Bus Station.

(ii) Subject to the provisions of these By-laws any licence issued under these By-laws shall remain in force from the date of issue thereof until the next following 31st December but shall be renewable on expiry for a further period of one year and thereafter from year to year.

(iii) The fee payable in respect of a licence for each Motor Omnibus under these By-laws shall be as follows: —

(iv) Every motor omnibus in respect of which a licence issued under these By-laws is in force, shall carry such licence on the nearside lower corner of the windscreen thereof, in such manner as to be clearly visible.

5. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any of the provisions of these By-laws shall be guilty of an offence and on conviction shall be liable to a fine not exceeding one thousand shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or to both such fine and imprisonment.

BY-LAWS

*Made under section 59*

THE DODOMA DISTRICT COUNCIL (CULTIVATION OF AGRICULTURAL LAND) BY-LAWS, 1965

1. These By-laws may be cited as the Dodoma District Council (Cultivation of Agricultural Land) By-laws, 1965.

2. In these By-laws—

“Authorized Officer” means an officer appointed by the Council for the purposes of these By-laws;

“Cash Crops” means any marketable agricultural produce and include groundnuts, maize, castor seed, cassava, millet and potatoes;

“Council” means the Dodoma District Council;

“Resident” means any person who has habitually resided in the area of jurisdiction of the Council for a period of not less than a year but does not include persons—
