Under section 5

THE EXPORT TAX (SISAL AND TEA) (AMENDMENT) (No. 2) RULES, 1963

1. These Rules may be cited as the Export Tax (Sisal and Tea) (Amendment) (No. 2) Rules, 1963.

2. The Export Tax (Sisal and Tea) Rules, 1962, are hereby amended by adding, immediately below rule 4, the following new rule: —

“Exemption: 5. The export to any East African territory of any tea
Consumption packaged in Tanganyika, which the Commissioner of Customs
in East is satisfied is to be consumed in such territory or in some
Africa other such territory or in Tanganyika, is hereby exempted
from the Export Tax.”
