**THE FAUNA CONSERVATION ORDINANCE**

(CAP. 302)

**ORDER**

*Under section 4*

THE FAUNA CONSERVATION (GAME RESERVES) (AMENDMENT) (No. 2)  
ORDER, 1965

1. This Order may be cited as the Fauna Conservation (Game Reserves) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1965.

2. The Sixth Schedule to the Fauna Conservation Ordinance is hereby amended by adding immediately below item 12 thereof the following new items: —

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“13. The Rumanyika Orugundu Game Reserve in the Karagwe District. Boundaries: Commencing at a beacon half a mile from the Nyakatuntu Game Scout post on the Nyakatuntu-Murongo track thence in a north-easterly direction along the Ilongwa Hills range to a beacon on Mtagata Hill; thence in a north-westerly direction along the Mashoro Hills range to a beacon on Bikoni Hill; thence in a northerly direction to a beacon on Rulonge Hill; thence westwards across the Kishanda Valley to a beacon at Makabingo; thence in a south-westerly direction following the Kazuro Hill; thence in a southerly direction following the Kisherere Hill range to a beacon at Kituntu; thence following the Nyakashenyi Hills range in a south-westerly direction following the Kazuro Hill; thence in a easterly direction to the beacon of commencement.

14. The Rubondo Island Game Reserve in the Geita District. Boundaries: All that area of land known as Rubondo Island and the surrounding waters to a limit of one hundred yards from the shore of the said Island as measured from the chart datum bench mark at Kisumu.”

3. Item 1 of the Sixth Schedule to the Fauna Conservation Ordinance (which item refers to the Mkomazi Game Reserve, Lushoto and Pare District) is hereby amended by deleting the boundary description and by substituting therefor the following new description: —

“Boundaries: From the summit of Kinondu Hill following a beaconsed line on a bearing of approximately 40 degrees to the northerly summit of Maji ya Juu Hill; thence in an easterly direction to the summit of Ndea Hill; thence in a north-easterly direction through the summit of Ngurunga (Ndea Ndogo) Hill to the Kenya boundary; thence south-eastwards along the Kenya-Tanganyika boundary to a point due north of Gerevi Hill; thence in a straight line due south through Gerevi Hill to the Uмба River; thence following the south bank of the Uмба River upstream (westwards) to a beacon on the said bank approximately due south of Mazunya

Hill and approximately one and a half miles east of the confluence of the Uмба and Nbaramu Rivers; thence in a straight line northwards to the summit of Mazunya Hill; thence in a straight line in a north-westerly direction to the summit of Kigongojiwa-Kubwa Ridge; thence in a straight line in a westerly direction to the Musambura water hole; thence in a westerly direction to the eastern summit of Karambatu Hill; thence in a south-westerly direction to the summit of Mabili (Usambaa) Hill; thence in a north-westerly direction to Kashugu water hole which is situated about two miles north of Mabili (Upare) Hill; thence in a straight line in a north-westerly direction to the summit of Masanzali Hill; thence on a magnetic bearing of approximately 310 degrees to a beacon situated on the south bank of the Kisiwani River; thence following the south bank of the Kisiwani River upstream to its first crossing of the main Kinurio-Same road; thence following this road towards Kisiwani for approximately four miles to the second crossing of the road over the Kisiwani River near the Kisiwani P.W.D. Road Camp; thence in a north-easterly direction to the summit of the Mwetakombohe Hill; thence in a north-westerly direction to the summit of Manola Hill; thence in a south-westerly direction along a cut trace towards Kwizu Hill as far as the main Kihurio-Same road; thence in a north-westerly direction following the south side of the said road to a beacon situated at the junction of the Kihurio-Same road with the Same-Ndea track; thence in a straight line in a northerly direction to the summit of Zange Hill; thence northwards along the watershed through Igiri Hill and Bumbuli Hill to the summit of Kinondu Hill, the point of commencement.”.

**ORDER**

THE FORESTS (KANKUMA TERRITORIAL FOREST RESERVE) (REVOCATION)  
ORDER, 1965

*Made under section 5 (1) and 33 (b)*

1. This Order may be cited as the Forests (Kankuma Territorial Forest Reserve) (Revocation) Order, 1965.

2. The area of the Kankuma Territorial Forest Reserve in the Bukoba District as described in the Schedule of Territorial Forest Reserves shall cease to be a Territorial Forest Reserve.
