THE LOCAL LIQUOR ORDINANCE (CAP. 77)

BY-LAWS

Under Section 56

THE NZEGA DISTRICT COUNCIL (LOCAL LIQUOR) BY-LAWS, 1965

1. These By-laws may be cited as the Nzega District Council (Local Liquor) By-laws, 1965.

2. The fees chargeable in the area of jurisdiction of the Nzega District Council for licences to manufacture and sell local liquor shall be as follows: —

for a six months' licence	...	...	...	Shs. 1,800/-
for a monthly licence	...	...	...	Shs. 400/-
for a temporary licence	...	...	...	Shs. 20/-

3. No fee shall be chargeable for a permit to manufacture local liquor for the purpose of private consumption on premises specified in the permit by the owner of such premises and his friends and not for the purpose of sale.

4. All licences and permits issued by the Licensing Officer shall be in the form set out in the Schedule hereto.

5. No local liquor shall be sold before the hour of 12.00 noon or after 6.00 p.m. on any day.

6. The Nzega District (Native Beer) (Control of Sales) Rules, 1951 are hereby revoked.
