THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE
(CAP. 333)

BY-LAWS

Made under section 59

THE DODOMA DISTRICT COUNCIL (LIVESTOCK MARKETS) BY-LAWS, 1965

1. These By-laws may be cited as the Dodoma District Council (Livestock Markets) By-laws, 1965.

2. In these By-laws—
"Council" means the Dodoma District Council;
"Livestock" includes Cows, Oxen, Bulls, Donkeys, Goats and Sheep;
"Market" means a livestock market established under the provisions of these By-laws and specified in the First Schedule hereto.

3. The places specified in the First Column and described in the Second Column of the First Schedule hereto are hereby established as markets.

4. No person shall purchase, sell or barter any livestock within the area of jurisdiction of the Council except at a market:

Provided that this By-law shall apply only to the first sale or purchase of livestock.

And provided further that sales or purchases may be made outside a market where prior permission in writing therefor has been obtained from the Council and where such sales or purchases are made for purely personal or domestic requirements.

5. Every market shall be under the supervision of an officer appointed by the Council for the purpose of regulating and controlling such market in accordance with the provisions of these By-laws, who shall be styled the Market master and who shall act under the directions of the Council.

6. Any person using a market shall obey all the reasonable directions given by the Council for the purpose of preserving cleanliness, order and regularity in the market and facilitating the dispatch of business therein, and in the case of any person failing to obey any such directions, the Market master may cause such person to be removed from the market. Such directions may include directions prohibiting the sale in, or directing the removal from, the market of any livestock which is unsound or infected with disease.

7. A market shall be open to the public between the hours of 9.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. on the market days and weeks of a month prescribed in the Second and Third Columns of the Second Schedule hereto.

8. No person shall buy, sell or barter any livestock in a market except on the day and between the hours specified in By-law 7 during which the market shall be open to the public.

9. All purchases made in the market shall be paid for in legal currency and purchase price shall be paid in the market at the time of purchase.

10. No person shall loiter, or cause an obstruction or commit any nuisance whatsoever in a market.

12. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any of the provisions of these By-laws shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding one thousand shillings or to a sentence of imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or to both such fine and imprisonment.

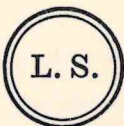
