BY-LAWS

Made under section 59

**THE HANDENI DISTRICT COUNCIL (CHANIKA MINOR SETTLEMENT)
TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) BY-LAWS, 1965**

1. These By-laws may be cited as the Handeni District Council (Chanika Minor Settlement) Traffic (Amendment) By-laws, 1965 and shall be read as one with the Handeni District Council (Chanika Minor Settlement) Traffic By-laws, 1964 (hereinafter referred to as the principal By-laws). G.N. 1964
No. 257

2. The principal By-laws are hereby amended by deleting By-law 4 thereof and substituting therefor a new By-law to be numbered 4:—

“4. Any officer of the Council authorized in writing for the purpose by the Area Commissioner may arrest any person contravening or failing to comply with the provisions of By-law 3 above if he has reasonable grounds for believing that such person will not attend a court in response to any process issued against him.”.
