BY-LAWS

Made by the Tabora District Council with the approval of the Minister for Local Government and Housing, under section 59 of the Local Government Ordinance

THE TABORA DISTRICT COUNCIL (SLAUGHTER AND HIDE DRESSING FEES)
BY-LAWS, 1965

1. These By-laws may be cited as the Tabora District Council (Slaughter and Hide Dressing Fees) By-laws, 1965.

2. The following charges will be made for the slaughter of animals by the Tabora District Council:—

Cattle, six months old or more	Shs. 2/00.
Pig, other than sucking pig	Shs. 2/00.
Sheep, goat, calf, under six months old or sucking pig	Sh. 1/00.

3. The following charges will be made for dressing and/or drying of hides by the Tabora District Council:—

Hide of cattle, six months old or more	Shs. 2/00.
Hide of sheep, goat or calf under six months of age ...	Sh. 1/00.
