BY-LAWS

Made under section 59

THE NORTH MARA DISTRICT COUNCIL (BUS STATION) BY-LAWS, 1965

1. These By-laws may be cited as the North Mara District Council (Bus Station) By-laws, 1965 and shall apply to the area known as the Tarime Urban Division.

2. In these By-laws—

“Council” means the North Mara District Council;

“Motor Omnibus” means any public service vehicle which carries or is intended to carry only passengers and their personal belongings and is licensed to carry more than seven passengers excluding the driver;

“Bus station” means the Bus station operated by the Council on the plot of land situated in the Uhuru Ground within the jurisdiction of the Council and any other Bus station which may be operated by the Council.

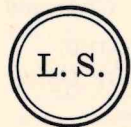
3. No motor omnibus shall embark or disembark any passenger or his personal luggage at any place within the area known as Tarime Urban Division other than at the Bus Station, Boma and Buhemba.

4.—(1) No Motor Omnibus shall use the Bus station unless the owner thereof is in possession of a valid licence issued in respect of such motor omnibus by the Council under these By-laws entitling such motor omnibus to use the Bus station.

(b) The fee payable in respect of a licence issued under these By-laws shall be Shs. 60/- per month or part of a month.

5. Any person who contravenes or fails to comply with any of the provisions of these By-laws shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding five hundred shillings or a sentence of imprisonment for a term not exceeding three months or to both such fine and imprisonment.
