**THE AFRICAN CHIEFS ORDINANCE**

(CAP. 331)

**ORDER**

**ORDER FOR THE DEPOSITION OF A CHIEF**

Whereas I, RASHIDI MFAUME KAWAWA, Prime Minister, am satisfied after due inquiry that the deposition of Chief Hamisi Tayari Simbambuti from the office of Chief of Kiberege in the Ulanga District, being an office of chief within the meaning of the African Chiefs Ordinance, is necessary in the interests of peace, order and good government:

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor-General by subsection (1) of section 13 of the African Chiefs Ordinance, and transferred to me by the Transfer of Powers and Duties (No. 2) Order, 1962, I, the said RASHIDI MFAUME KAWAWA, Prime Minister, do hereby depose the said Chief Hamisi Tayari Simbambuti from the said office of Chief of Kiberege.

**THE AFRICAN PRODUCE (CESS) ORDINANCE**

(CAP. 323)

**ORDER**

*Made under section 3*

THE AFRICAN PRODUCE (CESS) (NZEGA DISTRICT COUNCIL) ORDER, 1962

1. This Order may be cited as the African Produce (Cess) (Nzega District Council) Order, 1962.

3. The cess shall become due on the last day of the month following the month in which the cotton was purchased.

4. For the purpose of calculating the amount of cess due the weight of the cotton purchased shall be deemed to be its weight at the time of delivery to a ginnery:

Provided that the cotton shall have been delivered to the ginnery before the date when the cess became due.
