Exemption of Tanganyika Government employees from the provisions relating to the number of persons to be carried on a vehicle driven by the holder of a provisional licence.

G.N. No. 195 (contd.)

"The proviso to S.20 of the Traffic Ordinance shall not apply to any employee of the Tanganyika Government who is the holder of a provisional licence and who is at the time receiving driving instruction or is being tested in a vehicle owned by the Government and in charge of a Government employee authorized to give such instruction or to carry out such test."
