THE SUBORDINATE COURTS ORDINANCE
(CAP. 3)

ORDER

Made under section 5 (8)

THE SUBORDINATE COURTS (MAGISTERIAL POWERS AND JURISDICTION)
(CONSOLIDATION) ORDER, 1962

1. This Order may be cited as the Subordinate Courts (Magisterial Powers and Jurisdiction) (Consolidation) Order, 1962.

2.—(1) Every administrative officer, other than any such officer who has been appointed to be a magistrate under subsection (4) of section 5 of the Ordinance, shall have the powers and jurisdiction of a third class magistrate for criminal work only and restricted to remands and applications for bail.

(2) Every reference to a magistrate contained in the written laws specified in the First Schedule hereto shall be deemed to include a reference to the administrative officers upon whom magisterial powers and jurisdiction are conferred by this paragraph.

(3) In this paragraph the expression "administrative officer" does not include a person who is acting as an administrative officer or who has been appointed an acting administrative officer.

3.—(1) Every person appointed to be an acting administrative officer shall have the powers and jurisdiction of a third class magistrate for criminal work only and restricted to remands and applications for bail.

(2) Every reference to a magistrate contained in the written laws specified in the Second Schedule hereto shall be deemed to include a reference to the persons upon whom magisterial powers and jurisdiction are conferred by this paragraph.

4.—(1) The Subordinate Courts (Magisterial Powers and Jurisdiction) (No. 2) Order, 1962, and the Subordinate Courts (Magisterial Powers and Jurisdiction) (No. 4) Order, 1962, are hereby revoked.
