THE TANGANYIKA (CONSTITUTION) ORDER IN COUNCIL,
1961

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS the Constitution of Tanganyika established by the Tanganyika (Constitution) Order in Council, 1961, makes provision for the establishment and powers of the Parliament of Tanganyika:

AND WHEREAS by section 39 of the Constitution it is, amongst other things, provided that the Sessions of Parliament shall be held at such place and shall commence at such time as the Governor-General may appoint:

AND WHEREAS it is provided in subsection (2) of section 1 of the said Order that where the Governor-General has power to do anything for the purposes of the said Order that power may at any time after the twenty-eighth day of November, 1961 be exercised by the Governor to such extent as may, in his opinion, be necessary or expedient to enable the Constitution to function as from the ninth day of December, 1961:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, RICHARD GORDON TURNBULL, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor and Commander-in-Chief of Tanganyika, do hereby proclaim that a Session of Parliament shall be held at the Karimjee Hall, Dar es Salaam, commencing on Monday, the eleventh day of December, 1961, at 9 o'clock in the forenoon.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of Tanganyika at Dar es Salaam this twenty-ninth day of November, 1961.
