THE PRISONS ORDINANCE
(CAP. 58)

RULES

Made under section 124

THE PRISONS (CLASSIFICATION OF PRISONERS) RULES, 1961

1. These Rules may be cited as the Prisons (Classification of Prisoners) Rules, 1961.

2. In these Rules "first offender" means a convicted criminal prisoner serving a sentence of imprisonment for the first time.

3.—(1) All male adult convicted criminal prisoners shall be classified either as Star prisoners or as Ordinary prisoners.

(2) Star prisoners shall be those prisoners who are first offenders and those prisoners who, not being first offenders, are suitable for treatment and training with first offenders.

(3) Ordinary prisoners shall be all prisoners other than Star prisoners.

(4) So far as prison accommodation permits, Star prisoners and Ordinary prisoners shall be accommodated separately.

REGULATIONS

Made under section 6

THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1961

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Service Commission (Amendment) Regulations, 1961, and shall be read as one with the Public Service Commission Regulations, 1960, as amended from time to time (hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations).

2. Regulation 29 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (b) thereof.

3. Regulation 33 of the principal Regulations is hereby revoked.

G.N. No. 129 (contd.)

4. Regulation 61 of the principal Regulations is hereby revoked and replaced by the following new regulation:—

“Engagement and transfer, etc., of officers on contract or agreement

61. The Permanent Secretary shall refer to the Commission—

- (a) the engagement in a public office of a person on contract or agreement terms of service, excluding overseas leave, of not less than twelve months;
- (b) the transfer between departments and posts of persons so engaged;
- (c) the passing by persons so engaged of proficiency bars.”
