THE CUSTOMS TARIFF (REMISSION OF CUSTOMS DUTIES) (OPEX) ORDER,
1965

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Tariff (Remission of Customs Duties) (Opex) Order, 1965.

2. The whole of the import duties and suspended duties payable by personnel recruited under the Opex Scheme and designated by the Minister for Finance to the Commissioner of Customs in respect of one motor vehicle imported within 3 months of first arrival which the Commissioner of Customs is satisfied was purchased by such designated persons prior to departure from a previous residence outside the territories are hereby remitted.
