ORDER

Under section 4

TRANSFER OF STATUTORY FUNCTIONS (MINISTER FOR FINANCE)

It is hereby directed that in the absence of the Minister for Finance from the Treasury during the period the 1st January, 1965 to the 18th February, 1965, all the powers, duties and functions conferred or imposed upon the Minister for Finance by any enactment shall be vested in the Minister of State in the President's Office (The Hon. A. Z. N. SWAI).

The directions relating to the transfer of the statutory functions of the Minister for Finance to the Hon. A. Z. N. SWAI, dated the 15th February, 1965 are hereby varied by deleting the words and figures "February, 1965" and by substituting therefor the words and figures "December, 1964".

These Directions shall have effect from the 1st January, 1965.

TRANSFER OF STATUTORY FUNCTIONS (MINISTER FOR AGRICULTURE,
FORESTS AND WILDLIFE)

It is hereby directed, with effect from the first day of March, 1965, that during the absence of the Minister for Agriculture, Forests and Wildlife from Dar es Salaam during the month of March, 1965, all the powers, duties and functions conferred or imposed upon the Minister for Agriculture, Forests and Wildlife by or under any enactment shall be vested in the Minister for Lands, Settlement and Water Development.
