THE NATIVE AUTHORITY (RECOGNITION) RULES, 1960

I. These Rules may be cited as the Native Authority (Recognition) Rules, 1960.

2. When a native authority is or shall have been declared to consist of the person or persons for the time being discharging specified functions, or being members of a specified council or group, a person shall be deemed to be lawfully discharging such functions or to be lawfully a member of such council or group if and so long as he is so recognized by the following persons:—

- (a) in the case of a native authority having an area of jurisdiction which falls within one district, the District Commissioner of that district;
- (b) in the case of a native authority (other than a Subordinate Native Authority) having an area of jurisdiction which does not fall within one district, the Provincial Commissioner of any province which contains the area or part of the area of jurisdiction of the native authority;
- (c) in the case of a Subordinate Native Authority, the District Commissioner of any district which contains the area or part of the area of jurisdiction of the Subordinate Native Authority.

THE NATIVE AUTHORITY (ESTABLISHMENT OF NATIVE  
AUTHORITIES WITH LIMITED POWERS) (AMENDMENT)  
ORDER, 1960

1. This Order may be cited as the Native Authority (Establishment of Native Authorities with Limited Powers) (Amendment) Order, 1960, and shall be read as one with the Native Authority (Establishment of Native Authorities with Limited Powers) Order 1954.

2. The Native Authority (Establishment of Native Authorities with Limited Powers) Order, 1954, is hereby amended by deleting paragraph 6.
