THE STATISTICS ORDINANCE, 1961

(No. 33 OF 1961)

REGULATIONS

Made under section 14

THE STATISTICS (AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION) REGULATIONS, 1962

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Statistics (Agricultural Production) Regulations, 1962.

2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires—

“farm” means a holding of land used for agricultural purposes—

(a) being a unit of five acres or more in the case of land situate outside a municipality, town or township; or

(b) being a unit of any area in the case of land situate within a municipality, town or township;

“person in charge of a farm” includes an owner or occupier of a farm and any person who as manager or agent is employed to manage or supervise the operation of a farm.

3. Any person in charge of a farm may be required by an authorized officer to make a return containing the particulars and information set out in the Schedule hereto in respect of each farm of which he had charge during the twelve months ending 31st October, 1962, or any financial year ending between 1st November, 1961 and 31st October, 1962.

4. For the purposes of the return required by these Regulations the authorized officer shall prepare and distribute forms in which the particulars and information required to be furnished under these Regulations shall be tabulated and every person required to make a return in accordance with the provisions of these Regulations shall make such return on such forms.

5. An authorized officer may require any person in charge of a farm to provide him, whether by answering questions or otherwise, with all such information as may be necessary to ensure that the particulars and information required are fully and accurately furnished by such person.

6. Any person required by an authorized officer to make a return in accordance with the provisions of regulation 3 shall do so within twenty days, or such longer period as the authorized officer may direct, of the requirement, and such return shall be made to The Chief Economist, Economics and Statistics Division, The Treasury, P.O. Box 796, Dar es Salaam.

SCHEDULE

1. Name of owner or occupier, postal address, name of farm, location of farm, land registry number(s), size of farm, and signature of person completing the return.
2. Capital expenditure during the last financial year.
3. Numbers of types of equipment on the farm on 31st October, 1962 (or end of financial year).
4. Costs of fuels and transport during the last financial year.
5. Utilization of land during 1962.
6. Crop production during last crop year.
7. Numbers of livestock on farm on 31st October, 1962 (or end of financial year) by type of animal.
8. Production of milk and milk products, numbers of livestock sold for slaughter or breeding, or consumed on farm, and number of eggs sold, during the twelve months ending 31st October, 1962 (or end of financial year).

REGULATIONS

Under section 2

THE NATIVE LIQUOR (APPLICATION) REGULATIONS, 1962

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Native Liquor (Application) Regulations, 1962.
2. The Native Liquor Ordinance is hereby extended to the whole of Tanganyika.
3. The Native Liquor (Application) Regulations are hereby revoked.
